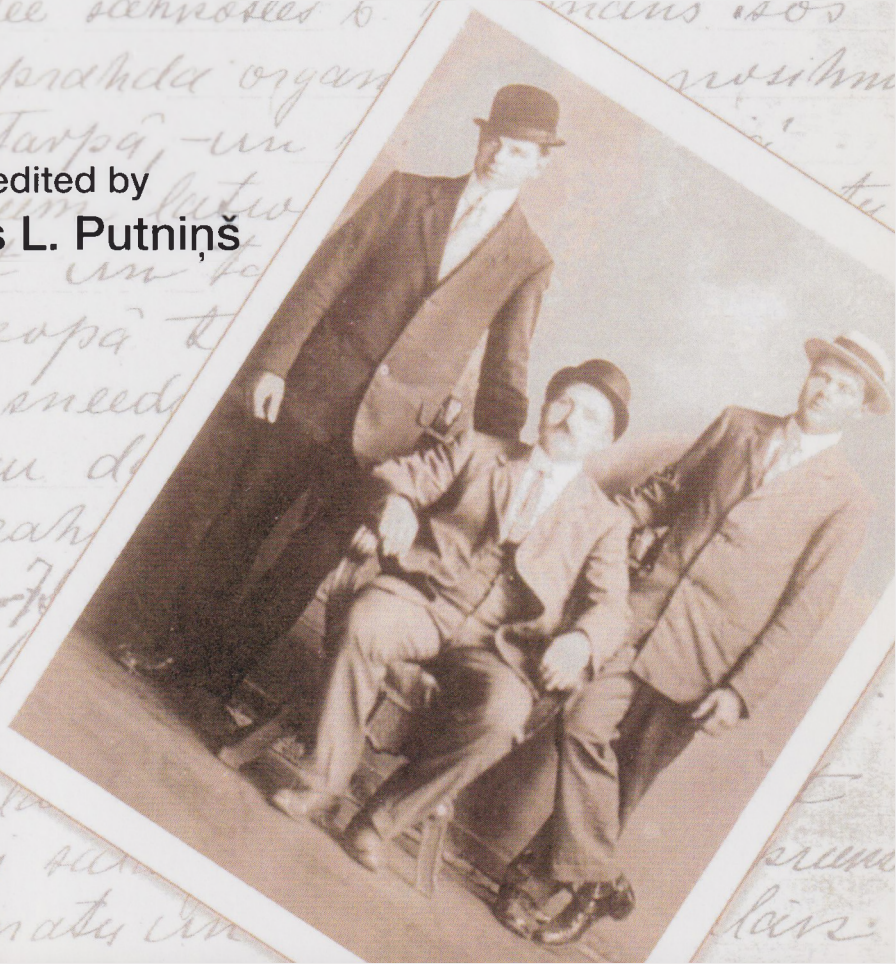

Latvian Anzacs: from Abelscaľn to Zeeman

Elena Govor and Aldis L. Putniņš

The following list of Latvian-born Anzacs has been compiled mainly from information recorded on Elena Govor's *Russian Anzacs* website (<http://russiananzacs.elena.id.au>), which contains further details about many of the persons mentioned here. Not all were Anzacs in the narrow sense of having served in the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps, but all were Anzacs in the popular and broader sense of having served in the Australian military during the First World War. While the ethnic backgrounds of most of the Latvian-born Anzacs are fairly clear, in some cases educated guesses have been made. Some of these could be revised by further historical research.

Abbreviations and explanatory notes

AIF — Australian Imperial Force; **aka** — also known as; **arr.** — arrived (in Australia); **b.** — born; **dis.** — discharged; **DOW** — died of wounds; **FAB** — Field Artillery Brigade; **GB** — Garrison Battalion; **KIA** — killed in action; **MG** — Machine Gun; **MM** — Military Medal; **MU** — medically unfit; **NSW** — New South Wales; **occup.** — occupation; **Place** — place of military service; **POW** — prisoner of war; **Qld** — Queensland; **resid. pre-arr.** — residence before arrival in Australia; **resid. pre-enlist.** — residence before enlistment; **RTA** — returned to Australia; **SA** — South Australia; **Tas** — Tasmania; **VDC** — Volunteer Defence Corps; **Vic** — Victoria; **WA** — Western Australia; **WF** — Western Front; **WIA** — wounded in action.

The place of service of enlistees who did not serve abroad is most often recorded as 'depot'. These were non-combat units, usually for training new enlistees.

Although in historical records Latvian placenames are often recorded in either their Russian or German forms, here they are given only in their modern Latvian form, for example Liepāja (not Libava or Libau), Ventspils (not Windau or Vindava), Jelgava (not Mitau or Mitava) and so on.

At 18 years joined a ship as a merchant seaman; worked mostly as a stoker in the boiler room. He travelled to many countries of the world over ten years. Visited Australia in 1907 and returned to London **arr.** 16.8.1909 Albany **resid.** **pre-enlist.** Kellerberlin, Culham, Toodyay, WA **occup.** fireman; after the war: farmer **enlisted** 27.1.1916 Blackboy Hill, WA **unit** 11th Battalion, 44th Battalion, 3rd MG Battalion **rank** Private **place** WF 1916-1919 **award** MM **RTA** 3.9.1919 **dis.** 10.12.1919 **resid.** **after war** Geraldton, Koolanooka, WA **WWII** served 1942-1944, 7th Geraldton Battalion VDC **died** 25.5.1944.
